

NOTICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Notice is hereby given in terms of the following legislation:

- Regulation 41 of Regulations published in Government Notice No. R698 of 20 July 2017 under Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act no. 107 of 1998),
- Section 40 and 41 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act no. 36 of 1998), and Regulations Regarding Procedural Requirements for Water Use Licence Applications and Appeals (No. R. 267, published 24 March 2017).

of the intent to carry out the following activities:

Activities & Locality:

The submission of an *ex post facto* S24G application for Environmental Authorization to the Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (LEDET) for the following listed activities which commenced without Environmental Authorisation in terms of Section 24G of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act no. 107 of 1998), as amended:

- *Activity 12 of R983 of 4 December 2014 as amended: "The development of dams or weirs, where the dam or weir, including infrastructure and water surface area, exceeds 100m²; within a watercourse.*
One (1) in-stream dam was constructed on the farm.
- *Activity 19 of R983 of 4 December 2014 as amended: "The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 10m³ into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 10m³ from a watercourse."*
More than 10m³ of soil was excavated from a watercourse for the construction of the dam.
- *Activity 16 of R984 of 4 December 2014 as amended: "The development of a dam where the highest part of the dam wall, as measured from the outside toe of the wall to the highest part of the wall, is 5 metres or higher or where the high- water mark of the dam covers an area of 10 hectares or more."*
One storage dam was constructed.

The abovementioned clearance took place on Portion 15 of the farm Rubbervale 784 LT in the Leydsdorp area.

An Integrated Water Use License Application (IWULA) will be submitted to the Department of Water and Sanitation for the applicable water uses in terms Section 21 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act no. 36 of 1998).
